## **Manchester Academy of Fine Arts**

This exhibition by members of Manchester Academy of Fine Arts features painters, printmakers and sculptors who represent the best of the contemporary art scene in the North West.

Since its foundation in 1859 the Academy has promoted fine art and education. Following this tradition exhibitions, often accompanied by workshops, podcasts and guided tours, are held usually twice yearly crossing boundaries in Yorkshire, Lancashire and Cheshire.

Young artists benefit from the Academy's special connection with Manchester Metropolitan University. Annual prizes are awarded to graduates, followed by the opportunity show their work in Academy exhibitions.

Noteworthy artists including Ford Madox Brown and John Cassidy, sculptor of the infamous Colston statue recently toppled into Bristol harbour, were active members of the Academy. L.S. Lowry, who first studied in Academy classes, exhibited in the annual shows for over forty years.

The work of present members, with all their diverse working practices, interpretations and use of different media, promises an exciting and varied exhibition.
